

ATHLETIC INFORMATION 2010 -2011

The athletic department offers programs in **10 different sports on 28 teams**, and offers a comprehensive Student Athletic Training Program. Rosary competes in the Trinity League and the CIF Southern Section. In addition to our summer Athletic program and our off-season training programs, our primary school year seasons are:

FALL Season (mid-August – mid-November): Cross Country, Tennis, Golf, and Volleyball

WINTER Season (mid-November – mid-February): Basketball, Soccer, and Water Polo

SPRING Season (mid-February – mid-May): Softball, Swim, and Track

TRYOUTS: Most try-outs will be held during the summer program which runs from mid-June to mid-August, depending on the sport. Each sport will have a 3 week dead-period during the summer. Athletes of all grade levels can be selected on any team depending upon their athletic abilities.

PRACTICES: Daily practices are held Monday – Friday, and some sports also practice on Saturdays. Times may vary with each sport and or level of participation.

FEES: There is a participation fee of \$450.00 for the first sport, \$275 for the second sport, and \$250.00 for the third sport. In addition, each athlete will be assessed a uniform fee for the consumable uniforms for each sport.

ELIGIBILITY: Eligibility paperwork, including pre-participation exams, 2 emergency cards, risk forms, codes of conduct for Rosary and CIF, must be submitted to the Athletic Office prior to any form of athletic participation. Pre-participation physical exams will be offered on campus on Tuesday, June 8. Additionally, all athletes must maintain academic eligibility of a 2.00 gpa and no Fs.

There will be a pre-season parent meeting for the parents of all athletes prior to each season. The Rosary Booster Club is the primary fundraiser for the Athletic Program. Parents are expected to participate and support the Booster Club Fundraisers.

There will be an Athlete/Parent meeting for all incoming freshmen who are interested in participating in Rosary's Athletic Program. The meeting will be held Thursday May 6, at 7:00 in the Karcher Center.
